

What is the Gospel ?



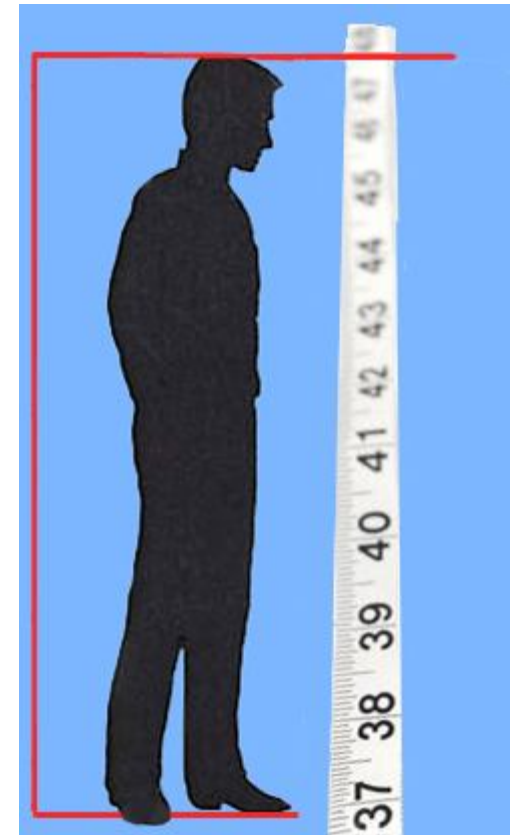
The word *Gospel* literally means “good news” -- the good news concerning Christ and His free gift of salvation.

WHY is the Gospel Good News?



The Old Testament Law was given to Israel during the time of Moses.

The Law can be thought of as a measuring stick, and sin is anything that falls short of “perfect” according to that standard.

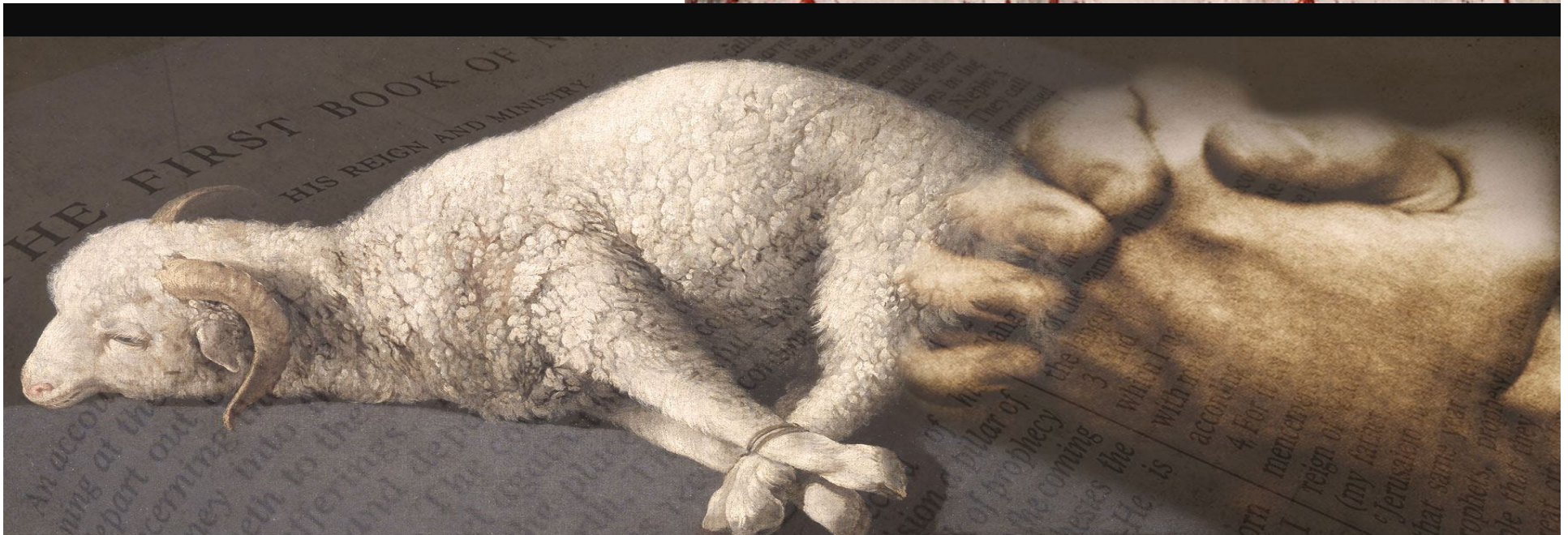



The righteous requirement of the Law is so stringent that no human being could possibly follow it perfectly, in letter or in spirit.



Despite our “goodness” or “badness” relative to each other, we are all in the same spiritual boat—we are sinners (we don’t measure up to the law), and the punishment for sin is death (according to the law). Death is separation from God.

In order for us to go
to heaven and be
reconciled to God, our
sin must be somehow be
removed or paid for.
The Law established
the fact that
cleansing from sin can
only happen through
the bloody sacrifice
of an innocent life.

(ISAIAH 53:5)

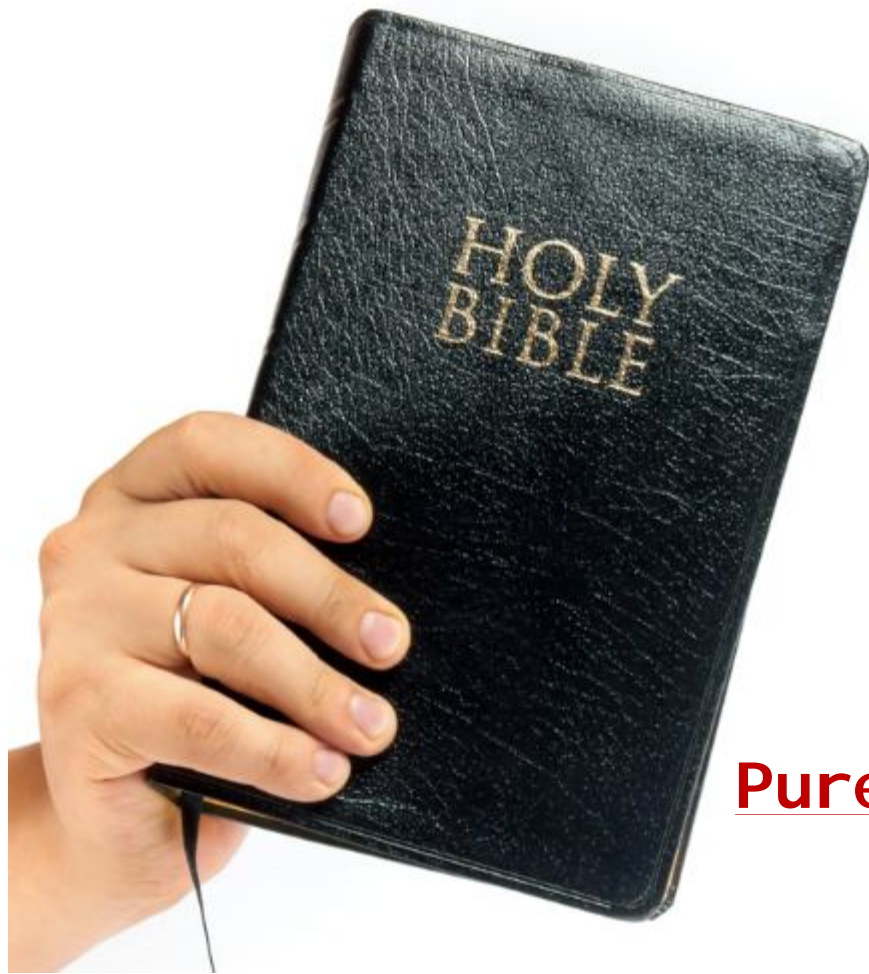
Jesus' willingly offered
